Mentoring Towards Excellence Materials

I am pleased to send you the enclosed materials. They are the outcome of a standards fund project undertaken jointly by the Association of Colleges and the Further Education National Training Organisation (FENTO) and involving 29 colleges. The aim of the materials is, firstly to identify what makes an excellent further education teacher and, secondly, to show how excellent teachers can help other teachers to raise their standards.
