The Committee reports to the Parliament as follows—

1. At its meeting on 5 March 2013, the Education and Culture Committee considered the following instrument—

The Children's Hearings (Scotland) Act 2011 (Transfer of Children to Scotland – Effect of Orders made in England and Wales or Northern Ireland) Regulations 2013 [Draft].

2. The order was laid on 16 January 2013 and is subject to affirmative procedure¹.
3. Aileen Campbell, Minister for Children and Young People, moved motion S4M-05714—

That the Children's Hearings (Scotland) Act 2011 (Transfer of Children to Scotland – Effect of Orders made in England and Wales or Northern Ireland) Regulations 2013 [Draft] be approved.

4. After debate, the motion was agreed to.
