The Prime Minister announced in <u>June that an initial £200 million of the £1.5</u>

billion in capital funding that will support the upgrading of the FE estate, will be

#### brought forward to financial year 2020 to 2021. This will support FE colleges to undertake immediate remedial work in this financial year to upgrade the condition of their estate and provide a boost as the country and its education system emerges from lockdown. We aim to share more details on the wider funding programme this autumn. This will include plans for investment in future years. Your grant letter and allocation amount are now available on Manage your education and skills funding service. You must sign your agreement by Friday 4 September to receive this grant in September.

This funding is for improving FE estates. It can only be used in accordance with
