

## Guidance for providers on publishing information about Reviews for Specific Course Designation

We ask that providers use the approved wording, below, to describe your relationship with the Quality Assurance Agency for Higher Education (QAA), and to publicise information relating to your Review for Specific Course Designation by QAA.

A QAA Review Graphic is also available for providers reviewed under Review for Specific Course Designation. The graphic complements the wording below: providers may use either element or both, to suit their requirements.

Please note that the QAA logo is not available for use by providers.

#### Text for use on your acceptance for a review by QAA

#### Text for use on receipt of your provisional judgement letter from QAA

# Text for use on receipt of your <u>email from QAA</u> confirming publication of your <u>review report</u>
