Average grade per A level, advanced level academic and vocational qualification

Average grades are published for each school and college in the 16 to 18 performance tables alongside the average point score per entry measures. Average grades are reported for A level, academic and a vocational qualification which helps interpret the average point score per entry as a grade.

The average grade per academic qualification is calculated using the average point score per academic entry. Similarly the average grade per A level and vocational qualification is calculated from the respective average point score per entry.

Average point score per entry calculation

An average point score per entry is calculated by dividing the total number of points achieved by students in a particular cohort by the total number of entries for those students.

For example, to calculate an average point score per academic entry, the total point score achieved by students in all academic qualifications is divided by those students' total number of academic entries. The average point score per vocational entry is calculated in the same way, but is only based on students entered for vocational qualifications and their results and so on for A levels. Average grade calculation

The average point score per entry is assigned an average grade based on the average point score band rules set out in Table 1 and 2 below.

Average grade per A level and academic entry is reported in terms of A level grades. Table 1 show the relevant point score bands for A levels and academic qualifications.

Average grade per vocational entry is reported in terms of BTEC Subsidiary Diploma (Level 3) grades. Table 2 shows the relevant point score bands for vocational qualifications.

A worked example of calculating an average grade per academic qualification based on a cohort of 5 students is shown in Table 3.
