Quarter 1 2017/18 Academic Report

Main Headlines

Applications received	54,900 applications were received for the 2017/18 academic year, to October 2017 (compared to 66,000 this time last year for 2016/17), with 41,010 applications being received between August and October 2017 (compared to 49,570 for this period this time last year – a decrease of 17.3 per cent).
Applications ready for payment	45,920 applications were ready for payment for courses starting in the 2017/18 academic year, to October 2017 (compared to 54,780 for this period this time last year).
Provision type	Level 3 Diploma qualifications continue to receive the most applications, with 19,130 received between August and October 2017 (compared with 25,960 this time last year for 2016/17), and 25,020 received overall for the 2017/18 academic year (33,400 this time last year for 2016/17). Access to Higher Education qualifications also received a large amount of applications, with 16,520 being received to October 2017 (17,740 this time last year for 2016/17).
Applicant demographics	From 2016/17 advanced learner loans were extended to those 19 and older (previously 24 and older). 14,020 applications have been received from the 19-23 age group for the 2017/18 academic year to October 2017 (compared to 16,100 this time last year for 2016/17). However the 24-30 year old age group continues to have the most applications with 15,650 (compared to 19,630 this time last year for 2016/17).

Changes to this statistical first release

In response to a review of the further education and skills statistical first release, its associated data cascade, and user feedback, We are proposing changes to the content, structure and periodicity. Headline advanced learner loans applications data will be subsumed into the main Statistical First Release on a biannual basis as part of the FE data library. The next SFR, and as a result the next data on applications, will be in March 2018.

This standalone publication will therefore cease production after this release.


- 1. This is a Department for Education report for the Advanced Learner Loans system and contains information relating to courses starting in the 2017/18 academic year. The previous 24+ advanced learning loans were expanded to those aged 19 and over starting in the 2016/17 academic year and have been renamed to 'Advanced Learner Loans'.
- 2. The report contains an outline of the data source, headline information and tables presenting application and processing figures. Information presented is as given in application forms and is subject to change.
- This release of Advanced Learner Loans Application Information covers applications submitted between 1 August and 31 October for the 2017/18 academic year. Applications for the 2017/18 academic year opened on 15 May 2017.

Data Source

The data used to produce this report are sourced from the live Student Loans Company (SLC) application database. The data refer to all applications received for Advanced Learner Loans, which include both unprocessed and processed applications, but exclude those ineligible, cancelled, deleted and in data entry. The live database provides information on applications, and is updated on an ongoing basis due to applications being processed, therefore data presented throughout the academic year are subject to change. A database snapshot provides data on applications (including application state) as it was held for any given date. This report uses application data on the 31 October 2017 for the 2017/18 academic year. Data presented in this report may also change for particular applications at some point in the future.

Figure 1 provides an overview of different application states. The state of an application can depend on various factors, including how much progress has been made processing the application, as well as the accuracy of the information and supporting evidence provided. In the Advanced Learner Loans report, the definition of applications received exclude those that are in data entry, ineligible, cancelled or deleted.

Figure 1 – Process map of application states



Applications move between different states on an ongoing basis. For example, an application may be in data entry and move to awaiting approval or an application that has been approved may move into the cancelled, deleted or in data entry state. It is therefore possible that the number of applications received could decrease from one month to the next if a large amount of applications move to the states in the red boxes and are no longer classed as an application received. Also, due to the changing of states, the sum of monthly application states over the course of the academic year will not equal the total for the full academic year.

Other Related Statistics

On 23 November 2017, the Department for Education published the <u>Further Education and Skills Statistical First Release</u>, which contains full year figures relating to the number of learners participating in FE who are funded through the Advanced Learner Loans system (<u>see Table 11</u>). Figures on learner participation include learners whose course started in previous academic years (2013/14, 2014/15 and 2015/16) that continued into 2016/17, so figures are not comparable to those in this report.

The Student Loans Company also publish their <u>Advanced Learner Loans Paid in England</u> which includes information on payments made to FE providers on behalf of loans-funded learners during from the 2013/14 academic year onwards. Data presented here relates to learners who are participating on a further education course funded by an advanced learner loan, and hence are not directly comparable to the application figures presented in this report.

On Thursday 15 June 2017, the Student Loans Company published <u>Debt and Repayment</u> <u>statistics for England</u>, which included figures debt and repayment relating to some Advanced Learner Loans for the 2016/17 financial year.
