Stakeholder update

Action: submit KS2 teacher assessment data by 28 June

The 'Teacher assessment' (TA) section of [NCA tools](#) is open. Schools must submit their key stage 2 (KS2) TA data for English reading, writing, mathematics and science by Thursday 28 June.

If your local authority is submitting TA data on behalf of some or all of your schools, you must also submit the data by this date.

We have provided [guidance](#) about which codes to use and how to upload your data.

Information: data protection - privacy notice model documents

The Department for Education has updated [documents](#) relating to privacy notices. The documents contain examples of sections to include and suggested formats for different audiences, which can be amended to reflect local needs and circumstances.

contains example privacy notices.

Reminder: make notifications for access arrangements by 25 May

Reminder: submit special consideration applications by 25 May

Reminder: complete the headteacher's declaration form by 25 May

Primary assessment

Information: KS1 and KS2 moderation window open from 4 June

Information: publication of 2018 test materials
