We're developing a two-year package to support new teachers at the start of their career, based on the <u>Early Career Framework</u>.

We aim to roll out the support package:

- to early rollout areas in September 2020
- <u>nationally</u> from September 2021

This is part of government's commitment to transform support for early career teachers.

## The support package

The support package includes:

• funded 5% time off timetable in the second year of teaching, in addition to the

existing 10% in the first year

- a range of high-quality, freely available curricula and training materials underpinned by the Early Career Framework
- funded training for mentors of early career teachers
- funded time for mentors to support early career teachers

# **The Early Career Framework**

The Early Career Framework was designed with an expert advisory group to support early career teacher development. It sets out what early career teachers will be entitled to:

- learn about
- learn how to do

The Early Career Framework includes sections on:

- behaviour management
- pedagogy
- curriculum
- assessment
- professional behaviours
