Destinations of Leavers from Scottish Schools: 1997-1998 to 1999-2000

### 1. Introduction


1.1 This is a new bulletin providing information about the destinations of leavers from Scottish schools. The information in this publication was previously supplied in a report entitled 'Leaver Destinations from Scottish Secondary Schools' which was issued by the former Audit Unit of Her Majesty's Inspector of Schools. The bulletin contains information on the destinations of school leavers from secondary schools in Scotland, including independent and grantaided schools. Summary information for education authorities and for Scotland is also shown.

## 2. Main Points

- 2.1 For the first time, over half (51 per cent) of the young people who left publicly funded schools continued into full-time further or higher education.
- 2.2 Nine out of ten young people who left independent schools continued in full-time education, the majority of whom entered higher education.
- 2.3 The percentage of school leavers from publicly funded schools entering employment has remained stable at 26 per cent for the past three years.

# 3. National Summary for School Leavers from Publicly Funded and Independent Schools

- 3.1 There were a total of 58,643 school leavers in 1999-2000 for whom information was available on destination on leaving school. Of these, just under 55,500 were from education authority schools and almost 3,100 were from independent schools. There were also just under 100 leavers from the only grant-aided school in Scotland, Jordanhill.
- 3.2 The information for independent schools is presented separately here. Unlike publicly funded schools, schools in this sector are independent of central and local government, and there is a distinctly different pattern of leaver destinations for these schools.
- 3.3 Table 1 below shows the pattern of leaver destinations nationally over the last eight years for publicly funded schools. It shows a continuing rise in the percentage of leavers entering both higher and further education over the period. Between 1992-93
- and 1999-2000, the percentage entering higher education increased from 25 per cent to 32 per cent and the percentage entering further education rose from 15 per cent to 19 per cent. Over the same time span, the numbers entering employment increased from 21 per cent to 26 per cent. While the percentage entering training has declined over the period, dropping from 19 per cent to 7 per cent, it should be noted that a large proportion of leavers entering employment may also be participating in training through the Skillseekers programme. See section 3.11 for further information on Skillseekers.
- 3.4 As shown in Table 2, the vast majority of school leavers from independent schools enter higher education. In 1999-2000, 83 per cent of school leavers from independent schools entered higher education compared with 74 per cent in 1995-96.



# School Leavers from Education Authority Schools: Comparisons between education authorities


- 3.5 There is variation in the pattern of leaver destinations between authorities. Location, proximity of higher and further education institutions and the local economic situation are all factors which may be influential in determining the destinations of leavers. Charts 2 to 6 show the percentage of leavers in each destination category across education authorities.
- 3.6 The education authority with the highest percentage of school leavers going on to higher education (Chart 2) was East Renfrewshire (50 per cent) followed by East Dunbartonshire (47 per cent) and South Ayrshire and Aberdeenshire (both 42 per cent); the percentages were lowest in Glasgow City (17 per cent) and Midlothian (24 per cent).
- 3.7 Angus education authority had the highest proportion of leavers entering further education (Chart 3) at 28 per cent, followed by Scottish Borders (27 per cent) and Dundee and Eilean Siar (both 26 per cent). The authorities with the lowest proportion entering

- further education were Stirling (12 per cent), Shetland Islands, Falkirk and East Lothian (all 13 per cent).
- 3.8 The percentage of leavers going on to training (Chart 4) was highest in Clackmannanshire and Falkirk (both 15 per cent) followed by Invercive (14 per cent).
- 3.9 The education authorities with the highest percentage of leavers entering employment (Chart 5) were Midlothian (44 per cent), followed by Shetland Islands (43 per cent), Edinburgh (39 per cent) and East Lothian (36 per cent). South Ayrshire (15 per cent) and North Ayrshire (16 per cent) had the lowest percentage of leavers entering employment.
- 3.10 The percentage of leavers going to other known destinations which includes unemployment (Chart 6) varies substantially between authorities ranging from 26 per cent for Glasgow City to 3 per cent for Eilean Siar.

School leavers entering higher education by education authority: 1999-2000 <sup>1</sup> Chart 2



# School leavers entering training by education authority: 1999-2000 <sup>1</sup>





# **Training Programmes: Skillseekers and Modern Apprenticeships**

- 3.11 The information collected for this bulletin on the proportion of school leavers entering training does not take account of leavers going on to employment who also receive training. This section provides available information on the numbers of young people receiving training through the Skillseekers programme; this programme enables many young people to gain employment with employers participating in the scheme.
- 3.12 Skillseekers was introduced in 1992 and achieved national coverage in 1996. The target group is 16 to 17 year olds (the Youth Guarantee group) and Local Enterprise Companies (LECs) have the discretion to fund training for young people 18 years and over. Skillseekers aims to provide young people with a valid work-based route to skills and qualifications. The key elements of Skillseekers are: the training must lead to a qualification up to SVQ Level III; an individual training plan; payment on achievement; and involvement of the employer.
- 3.13 In 1996, the Skillseekers programme was extended to include Modern Apprenticeships (MAs). MAs are again mainly

- aimed at 16 to 17 year olds. LECs have the discretion to fund 18 to 24 year olds but training must be completed by the 25<sup>th</sup> birthday. MAs are industry-designed frameworks aimed at training young people for jobs at craft, technician and trainee management level. Training must lead to an SVQ Level III or above and include Core Skills and can include other qualifications relevant to the occupational sector.
- 3.14 In Scotland, Skillseekers and Modern Apprenticeships have succeeded in attracting a large number of employers to give young people employed status. At October 2000, 76 per cent of Skillseekers received a wage (99 per cent for Modern Apprenticeships).
- 3.15 The proportion of school leavers entering employment who are also on the Skillseekers programme is not known; however, the following table gives the numbers of young people on Skillseekers training at the end of October for the past three years. In October 2000, there were almost 39,300 Skillseekers which included 16,200 Modern Apprentices.

### Statistical Notes and Definitions

### 1. Sources

The 1999/2000 data for this bulletin is based on the information available on 20 October 2000.

Annual information is provided to The Scottish Executive by the careers services. Information from independent and grant-aided schools is collected directly from the schools.

The data relate to the latest known destinations of leavers at the time the information is collected. For example, a school leaver who left in June 2000 and was unemployed for 4 months until early October, but who is known by the careers service to have taken up a college place prior to 20 October will be counted under further education.

### 2. School Leavers

In this bulletin, a school leaver is a young person of school leaving age who left school during or at the end of the school year, where the school year is taken to run from 1 August to 31 July.

In practice, many young people do not decide whether or not to leave school until after they have received the results of external examinations or have tried to get a job or achieve entry to further or higher education or training. For many pupils, therefore, it is only possible to identify later whether they have effectively left school by 31 July. There may also be slight differences in the way careers services count leavers who return to school for a short period after the summer break. Thus full comparability between education authorities cannot be assured.

It should be noted that the bulletin does not contain information on the destination of leavers from special schools. Leavers from these schools are few in number and fluctuate from year to year.

## 3. Leaver Destinations

The following categories for leaver destinations are included in the bulletin. These are also described in the Regulations in the SOED circular 10/93 on the *Information for Parents in Scotland*.

Full-time Higher Education - includes leavers following HND (Higher National Diploma) or HNC (Higher National Certificate) courses, degree courses, courses for the education and training of teachers and higher level courses for professional qualifications. It also includes, for the purposes of this report, other courses above the standard of the Scottish Certificate of Education Higher Grade, the Certificate of Sixth Year Studies, the National Certificate or the General Certificate of Education of England and Wales or Northern Ireland at Advanced level. Leavers with a deferred, unconditional place in higher education have also been included in this category.

Full-time Further Education - includes leavers undertaking full-time education which is not higher education and who are no longer on a school roll.

**Training -** includes leavers who are on a training course where an allowance or grant is paid, such as Skillseekers, but who are not employed.

**Employment** - includes those who are employed for a minimum of 21 hours per week and who are in receipt of payment from their employers. It includes young people undertaking training in employment through Skillseekers. Where a leaver has more than one job, the leaver will be included in the employment category if they have worked more than 21 hours in total.

Other Known Destinations - includes school leavers who are known by the education authority or school to be unemployed, sick, at home looking after children or caring for the elderly, involved in full-time unpaid voluntary work, or taking time out. This category is a very wide one but it is not possible at present for the careers services to provide information that reliably distinguishes between school leavers who are unemployed or who are employed and/or in education part-time for less than 21 hours per week and those covered by the other options under the heading. It should be noted that this category may include some leavers with more than one

**Unknown** - includes all leavers whose destinations are not recorded by the careers service or independent or grant-aided school.

# 4. Interpretation of figures for individual schools

The following points should be noted when comparing figures for individual schools.

- Increasing numbers of school leavers are taking a 'year out' for many constructive purposes before continuing their education or entering employment. Apart from pupils with a deferred unconditional place for Higher Education, pupils taking a 'year out' are included in the 'other known destinations' category. Details on the number of such pupils may be obtained from individual schools.
- The destinations of leavers from individual schools may depend partly on location.
   For example, in many rural and island areas, young people have to travel long distances or live away from home in order to take up courses in higher or further education.
- Economic factors may affect the availability of employment in the local area. A major construction project or the opening of an industrial enterprise may present many new opportunities. Equally, lack of local employment may encourage leavers towards further education or training.
- In certain areas, or particular years, the pattern of school leaver destinations may be affected by the implementation of Skillseekers, the existence of an education-business partnership or special arrangements for entry to higher education.
- There may be a strong local tradition for pupils either to stay on at school or to leave school as early as possible, affecting the numbers who stay on long enough to gain the necessary entrance qualifications for higher education.
- Schools which offer education only up to S4 do not in general offer the qualifications necessary for leavers to

Such schools are identified (S1-S4) in the tables.

- Some education authority schools are designated to receive pupils from schools which only offer education in S1 to S4 to continue their education in S5 and S6. Such schools may gain a significant proportion of pupils beyond the statutory leaving age who are interested in further and higher education. The schools whose figures could be affected in this way are identified in the tables. In some cases, this may be a temporary situation which has arisen for one year because of the closure of a neighbouring school.
- Some schools have special units which make provision for pupils who have learning difficulties. The destinations of these pupils are included in the figures in the tables and this might have a significant effect on the overall pattern of leaver destinations. However, the overall effect will be heavily dependent on the number of pupils in the special unit and the nature of their needs.
- Fluctuations in the figures from year to year are likely. For example, differences in the proportion of leavers proceeding to higher education may derive from the ability of pupils in a particular year group. Similarly, there may be short-term opportunities for employment in some localities. In small schools with only a few leavers, small changes in the number of leavers in each destination category can make a big difference in percentage terms from year to year.

## 5. Symbols

Two asterisks (\*\*) have been inserted in the tables in the following circumstances:

- a) where the number of leavers in any category is between 1 and 4.
- b) for 'unknown destinations' where otherwise it would be possible to calculate the number of leavers less than 5 in another category.

Two hashes (##) have been inserted where a school has recently opened or merged with another school and the required information is not available.
