Before Clause 20

LORD WILLIS OF KNARESBOROUGH

Insert the following new Clause—

“The school technology policy

- (1) The head teacher shall formulate a policy for the use of, and teaching of technology (including information and communication technology) in the curriculum of the school (“the technology policy”) for adoption by the governing body.
- (2) The head teacher shall take into consideration any advice about the use of or teaching of technology (including information and communication technology) issued by the Secretary of State.
- (3) The head teacher shall review the technology policy every school year and shall formulate any necessary changes to the technology policy for adoption by the governing body.
- (4) The head teacher shall implement the technology policy adopted by the governing body.
- (5) The governing body shall—
 - (a) consider the technology policy formulated by the head teacher and adopt it, with or without modifications, or remit it to the head teacher for reformulation;
 - (b) consider any advice issued by the Secretary of State;
 - (c) monitor, evaluate and review the implementation of the technology policy; and
 - (d) consider and adopt, with or without modifications, or reject any changes to the technology policy proposed by the head teacher.”
