B E IT ENACTED by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 Amendment to the Mental Health Act 1983

Section 141 of the Mental Health Act 1983 is repealed.

2 Amendments to the Juries Act 1974

- (1) Schedule 1 to the Juries Act 1974 is amended as follows.
- (2) For paragraph 1 substitute –

- "1 A person for the time being liable to be detained under the Mental Health Act 1983.
- 1A A person for the time being resident in a hospital on account of mental disorder within the meaning of the Mental Health Act 1983.".
