# Students outside the student number control in 2014-15 Exemptions list

The Government has requested that HEFCE no longer places controls on the recruitment to higher education of students with very high grades prior to entry. From 2014-15, this group of students is defined as those who achieved grades of ABB, or above, at A-level, or certain equivalent qualifications to this. In addition, HEFCE will no longer place controls on students holding the most common combination of qualifications as equivalent to ABB at A-level; specific criteria were applied when determining whether a combination of qualifications should be listed on the exemptions list:

- a. The combination of qualification types comprises A-level and one other qualification type which is present on the HEFCE exemptions list. We included the most favourable combination of one or two A-levels with one other qualification type, that amount to a total size equivalent of no more than three A-levels.
- b. The combination of qualifications is reported and present in the most recent data for setting student number controls.
- c. We are able to list them formally in terms of qualifications and grades exempted, to ensure the approach can be implemented by institutions and HEFCE. This means any qualification included in a combination must be one for which grades are awarded.
- d. Any combination of qualification types should reach a threshold of 100 students across the monitored population in the most recent available data.

Below is the complete list qualifications that are exempt from the student number control. All other qualifications and grades remain within the student number control. However institutions are provided with a student number control that reflects prior recruitment, which enables them to accommodate students entering with European qualification equivalences, and those qualifications not covered by the exemption list, and contextual admissions.

The most highly selective institutions will also continue to be provided with a fair-access protection allocation. This will provide additional places to ensure these institutions can continue to offer fair access to students with high entry qualifications who are not included on the exemptions list.

This exemptions list has been developed solely for the practical and limited purpose of implementing the Government's student number control policy, and is, in essence, a technical response to implementing Government policy in a manageable way. The exemptions list in no way provides an exhaustive assessment of students' prior attainment. We would not expect institutions to use this list to inform decisions about the quality of students' qualifications, the admission of individual applicants, or students' eligibility for institutions' own scholarship, bursary or fee waiver schemes. The list is not intended to influence the determination of individual applicants' suitability for admission, where the autonomy of institutions is always paramount.

Students with DipHE, Certificate of Higher Education (CertHE), or Higher National Certificate (HNC) qualifications will still be part of the control. This is because these qualifications are not usually taken with the intention of being a progression route to topping up to a degree, and do not have to have a clear progression route as FDs do.
