Introduction

1. Summer schools grant 2014-2015 will be paid pursuant to Section 14 of the Education Act 2002, and in accordance with Section 16 of that Act the Secretary of State lays down the following terms and conditions on which assistance is given in relation to the summer schools grant payable to the academy for the financial year beginning 1 April 2014.

Basis of allocations to academies

- 2. The Department has made a **provisional** allocation for each academy's summer schools funding. A schedule of schools taking part in the programme in each local authority is set out on the accompanying spreadsheet. The allocations are based on £250 per **eligible** pupil per week, identified by each participating secondary school that will run a summer school.
- 3. Summer schools funding allocations will be **adjusted in October 2014** when schools submit confirmation that the summer schools took place and confirm the number of eligible pupils who attended. A revised spreadsheet will be issued with the final breakdown of 2014 to 2015 summer schools funding, by eligible school.

Payment arrangements

- 4. Summer schools funding will be paid by the Secretary of State to the Academy in two instalments:
 - June 2014 (50% of provisional allocation)
 - October 2014 (remainder of final allocation)

Overpayments

5. Any overpayment of grant shall be recovered against the General Annual Grant by the Academy to the Secretary of State.

Further information

6. The books and other documents and records relating to the recipient's accounts shall be open to inspection by the Secretary of State and by the Comptroller and Auditor General. The Comptroller and Auditor General may, pursuant to Section 6 of the National Audit Act 1983, carry out examinations into the economy, efficiency and effectiveness with which the recipient has used its resources in discharging its grant-aided activities.

7. The academy shall provide such further information as may be required by the Secretary of State for the purpose of determining whether it has complied with the conditions set out in this document.

Other conditions

8. If the academy fails to comply with the conditions set out in the paragraphs above, the Secretary of State may require the repayment of the whole or any part of the grant monies paid to the academy as may be determined by the Secretary of State and notified in writing to the academy. Such sum as has been notified shall immediately become payable to the Secretary of State.
