## Version 2 Addendum 1

Rationale for publication: revised traineeship policy



Of interest to providers and employers delivering traineeships

## Introduction

- 1. This document sets out an amendment to Funding Rules 2014/2015 Version 2.
- 2. The amendment forms part of the terms and conditions of the funding agreements and the 24+ Advanced Learning Loans Facility Conditions between the Chief Executive of Skills Funding and all providers of education and training who receive funding from the Chief Executive of Skills Funding or a 24+ Advanced Learning Loan (Loan) Facility.
- 3. The amendment updates the rules to include the extension to the learner eligibility criteria for traineeships, detailed in the government's response to the traineeship consultation. A copy of the consultation can be found <u>here.</u>
- 4. We will apply the change to the funding rules from 1 January 2015. It applies only to learners who start a traineeship on or after that date.
- 5. We have identified the amendment by striking through the text that is no longer applicable and underlining text that we have added.
