#### **Overview**

School Direct (Early Years) places are allocated to lead organisations

(schools and nurseries). This approach to teacher training enables lead organisations to work in partnership with accredited ITT providers. School Direct (Early Years) lets lead organisations:

- influence how early years teachers are trained
- recruit trainees that best meet their partnerships' needs
- offer trainees work after completing their training within the group of schools/nurseries they trained in
- decide which accredited <sup>ITT</sup> provider to work with under a partnership agreement
