

Statistical notice: Entries to arts subjects: 2009/10 to 2013/14

For the purposes of these figures arts subjects have been defined as Applied Art and Design, Art and Design, Drama, Media/Film/TV, Music, Dance and Performing Arts.

The table on page 2 shows a five year time series for the number of pupils at the end of key stage 4 with entries into arts subjects (as defined above) and the number and percentage of pupils with an entry into at least one arts subject.

The number of pupils with an entry into at least one arts subject is lower than the total number of entries into arts subjects because pupils can enter more than one arts subject, and pupils with more than one entry are only counted once.

Figures for individual subject entries are taken from Table 22 of the Revised GCSE and equivalent results in England: 2013 to 2014 Statistical First Release. The exceptions are the figures for dance, which in the Statistical First Release are reported as part of the Physical Education subject grouping.
