


# ANNUAL STATISTICS DIGEST MARCH 2016



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### Introduction

### **Background**

On 1 April 2015 the GTCW was reconfigured as the Education Workforce Council (EWC) with responsibility for the regulation of school teachers and further education (FE) teachers. On 1 April 2016, FE and school learning support workers joined the Register and these will be followed in April 2017 with youth workers and work based learning practitioners.

The EWC is the independent regulator for teachers and learning support staff in maintained schools and FE institutions in Wales. We aim to contribute to improving standards of teaching and the quality of learning in Wales, as well as maintaining and improving standards of professional conduct within the workforce in the interests of learners, parents and the public.

#### **Introduction to this Digest**

The Annual Statistics Digest has been produced from the EWC Register of Education Practitioners and the information that we are able to hold on the Register is set out in the Education Workforce Council (Main Functions) (Wales) Regulations 2015, as amended.

As FE teachers have only been registered with the Council since 1 April 2015 the data included is limited to gender and age profile. The Council is undertaking a programme of work to populate FE teacher records and will publish more specific data as records become more complete.

In previous years there have been four sections to the Digest relating to school teachers. This year we have included data on all registered school teachers without the additional sections relating to NQTs and headteachers. Data on those specific groups will be released separately during the year.

It is important to note that the Digest contains data based on the following criteria:

- In the school teacher section, included are those practitioners currently registered to work in the maintained schools sector. In the FE teacher section, included are those practitioners currently registered to work in an FE institution. In addition, in both sections, there are registered practitioners who may not be working but have chosen to register with their professional body.
- Practitioner numbers are 'displayed as 'actuals' rather than full-time 'equivalents'.
- Supply teachers are counted once only in each section regardless of the number of employers they may work for.
- Where a practitioner is registered as both a school and FE teacher they are included in both sections.

The census date used for the data taken from the register is 1 March 2016.

These criteria differ from other information sources, such as those published by the Department for Education and the Welsh Government.

In section 1, where possible, we have provided a five year data trend unless the volume of data limits the space available to a three year trend.

We have published the Statistics Digest as the GTCW annually since March 2001 and copies from each year are available to download from our website www.ewc.wales if required.









Welsh speaker - March 2016




Able to teach through the medium of Welsh - March 2016



### Number of school teachers registered with EWC by subject taught (secondary phase working only) - March 2016







#### **Data Definitions and Assumptions**

- 1. The data contained in this Digest is based on a number of specific criteria. The following assumptions apply to all tables in the report.
  - All data in this report includes school teachers registered with the Education Workforce Council (EWC).
  - Supply teachers in each section are only counted once regardless of the number of LA supply lists on which they are included or supply teacher agencies they work for.
- 2. In section 1, data produced in respect of phase is based on the employment details on the Register as at the 1 March 2016.

In considering the data it should be noted that:

- there is no legal obligation for teachers, schools, Las or FE colleges to notify EWC of the teacher posts within a school or college;
- in the school teacher section, in the primary and other phases there is a noticeable absence of assistant headteacher and deputy headteacher positions.
- 3. For the data provided in respect of subjects the following definitions apply to the relevant tables:-
