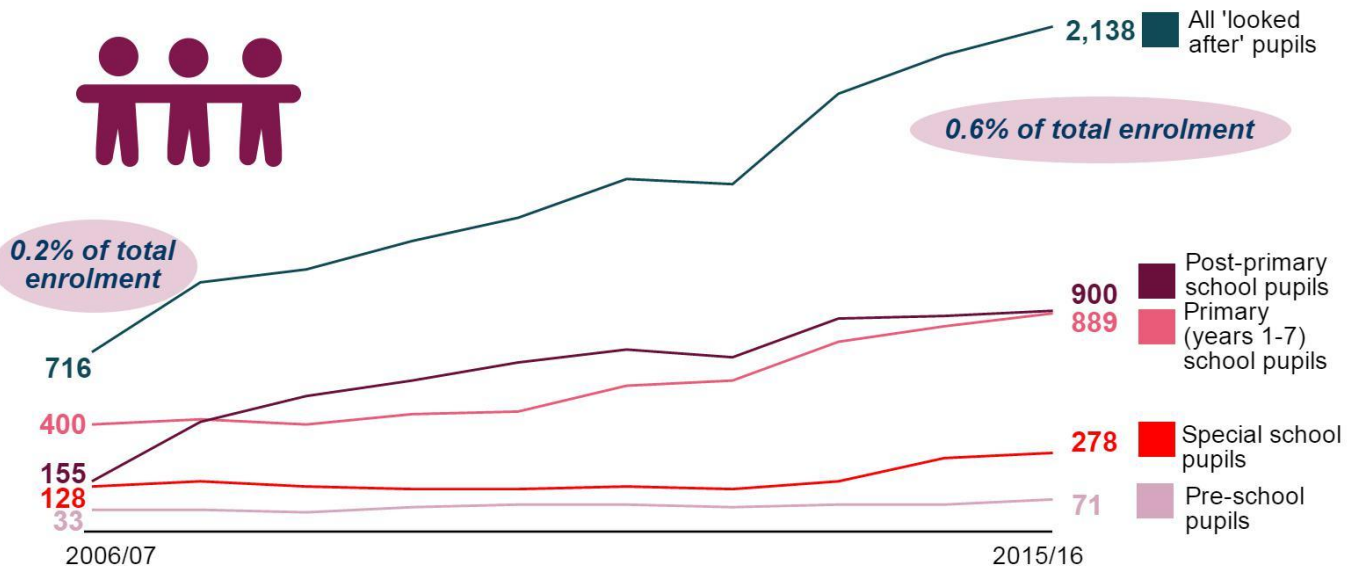


Who are 'looked after' children?

'Looked after' children:

Any child looked after by an authority, either:
 (a) in the care of the authority; or
 (b) provided with accommodation by the authority.
 This includes children who are fostered.

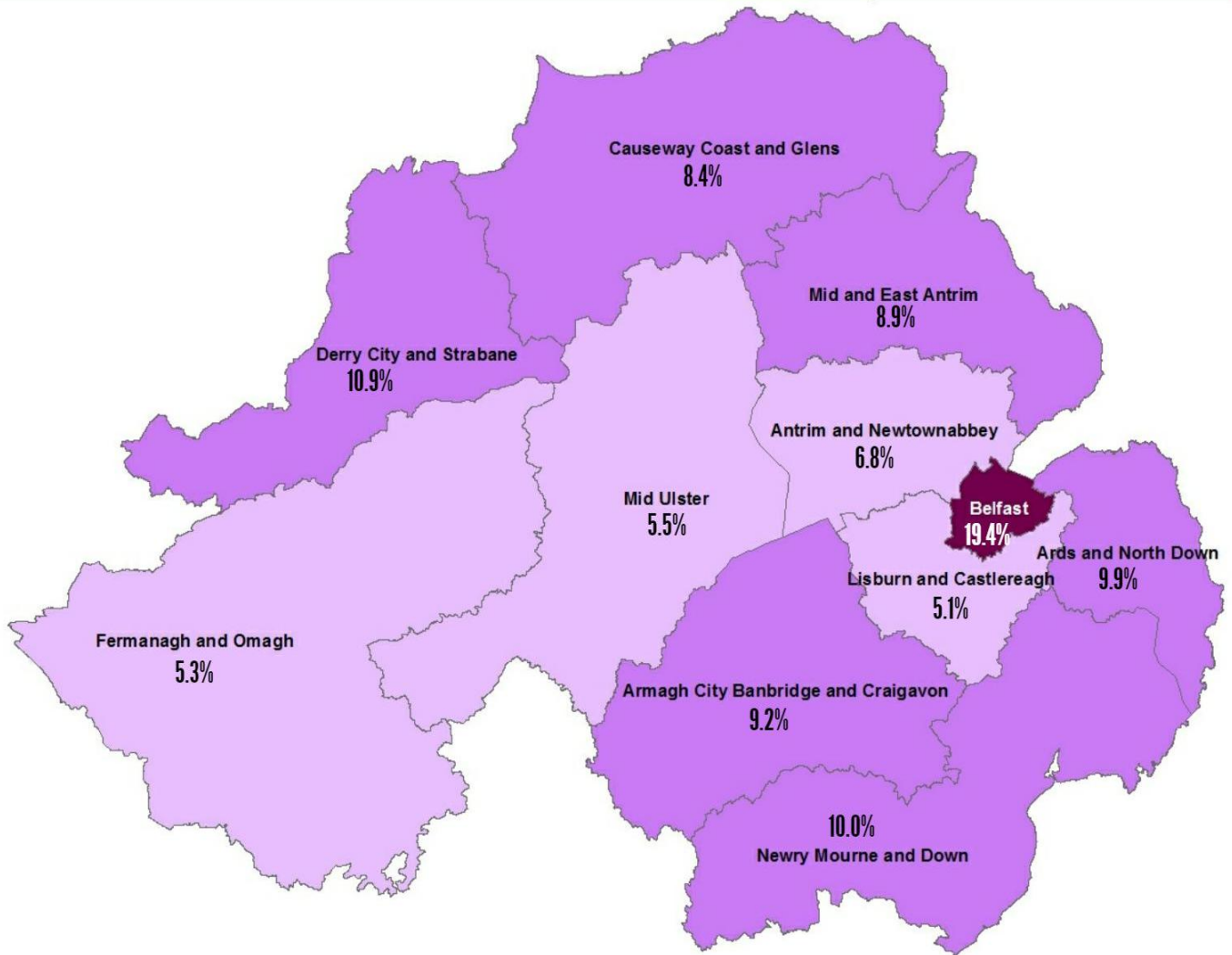
'Looked after' children enrolments



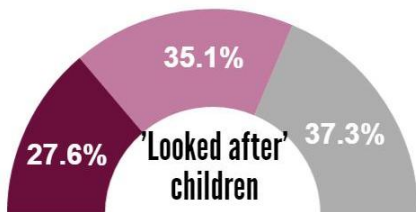
Schools with 'looked after' children



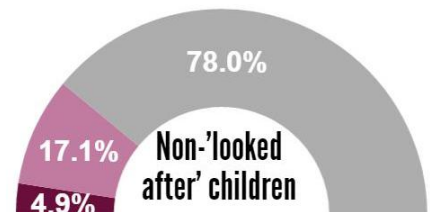
Distribution of Council area which 'looked after' pupils reside

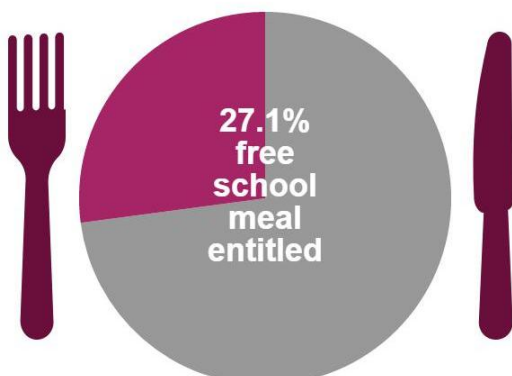

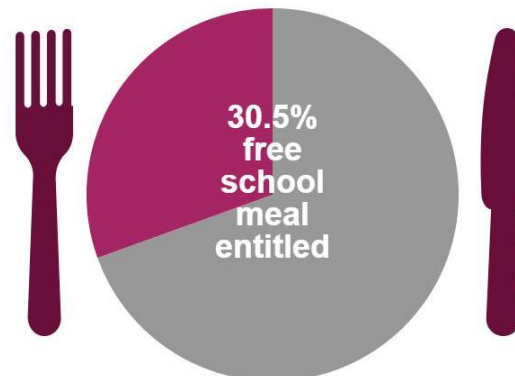

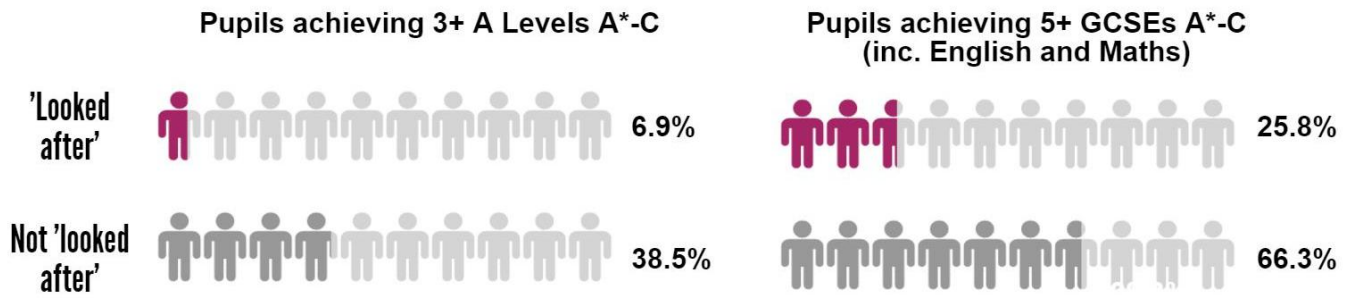

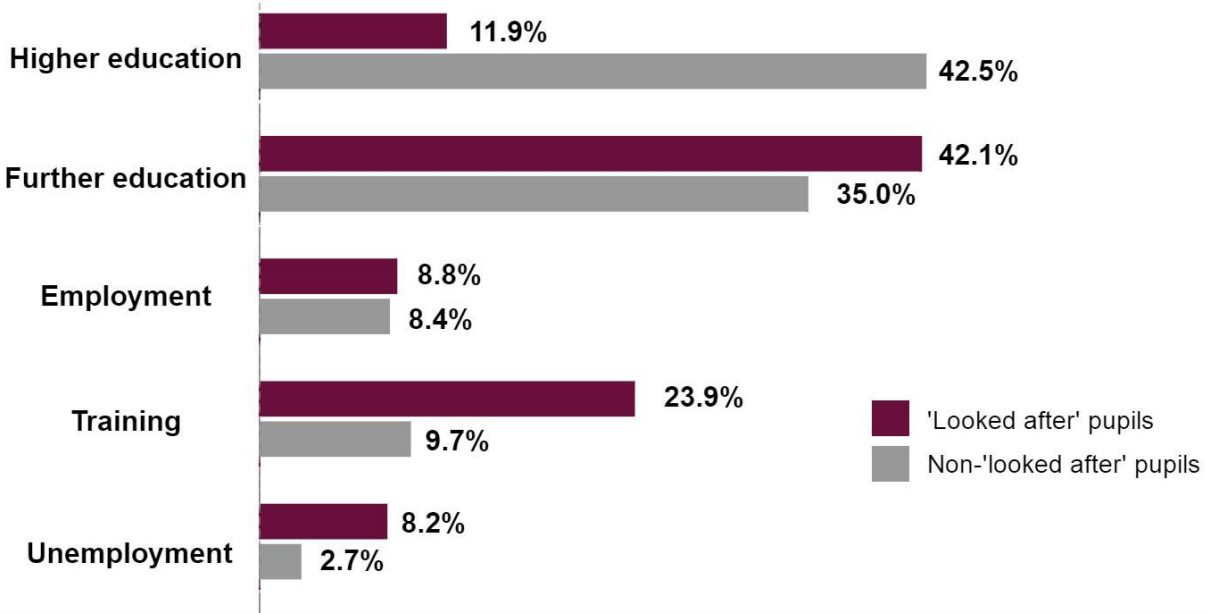
Non-'looked after' children
