

## Action: arrange scribes or readers for KS2 tests

Read the <u>key stage 2 access arrangements guidance</u> to familiarise yourself with the range of access arrangements available for the tests. You should consider your pupils' needs and the support they receive as part of normal classroom practice to decide whether any specific arrangements will be needed in May.

You may need to arrange additional staff to act as readers or scribes, so we encourage you to start planning these arrangements so that everybody involved in administering the tests is able to familiarise themselves with the guidance.
