1. Reminder: maintained nursery school (MNS) data assurance

We've launched the maintained nursery school (MNS) data assurance exercise. This exercise will ensure the accuracy of data used in the MNS supplementary funding calculation in the early years national funding formula.

The exercise only applies to local authorities with maintained nursery schools. We have contacted these local authorities directly. We'll publish the <u>supporting guidance</u> on GOV.UK by Friday 17 March 2017.

The exercise will close on 30 March 2017.
