- (a) FPI: The Foundation Phase Indicator represents the percentage of pupils achieving the expected outcome or above in "Language, literacy and communication skills" (in English or Welsh), "Personal and social development, wellbeing and cultural diversity" and "Mathematical development" in combination. The expected outcome of the majority of pupils is outcome 5 at the end of the Foundation Phase.
- (b) CSI: The Core Subject Indicator represents the percentage of pupils achieving the expected level or above in English or Welsh (first language), mathematics and science in combination. The expected level at Key Stage 2 is Level 4 and at Key Stage 3 is Level 5.
