## Key stage 3

# Action: access key stage 2 (KS2) test results on NCA tools for incoming year 7 pupils

Schools with a key stage 3 (KS3) intake can access the results of the 2017 KS2 tests in the 'Pupil results' section of NCA tools for incoming year 7 pupils.

You will need unique pupil numbers (UPNs) to access the results of pupils joining your school in September.

Each pupil receives:

- a raw score
- a scaled score
- confirmation of whether or not they met the expected standard (a scaled score of 100 represents the expected standard)

Information: question level analysis of KS2 test results

By the end of July, question level analysis will be available to schools with incoming year 7 pupils via <u>Analyse School Performance</u> (ASP). It will be available from the 'Question level analysis' tab.

This will enable schools to see how pupils performed in different areas of a test, or in answering individual questions compared to other pupils nationally.
