

# Publication: phonics and KS1 teacher assessment data published

You may have seen that we published <u>provisional data</u> for the 2017 phonics screening check and key stage 1 (KS1) teacher assessments on Thursday 28 September.

The statistical release includes data breakdowns by local authority and region, school characteristics and pupil characteristics, including gender, ethnicity, special educational needs and free school meal eligibility.

## Key stage 2

## Publication: KS2 science sampling materials

We've published the <u>2016 science sampling materials</u>. This includes the test booklet, mark scheme and a commentary on selected questions.

These materials should be used to support primary school teachers with science teaching and teacher assessment at key stage 2 (KS2).

Modified versions will be available later in the autumn term.

### Information: provisional 2017 KS2 data now available

KS2 data is now available in <u>Analyse school performance</u> (ASP), the replacement service for RAISEonline. This is provisional data for the 2016 to 2017 test cycle. Data about looked-after children is currently unavailable, therefore we have not published breakdowns of data such as disadvantaged children. This will be added at the end of October with KS1 and phonics screening check data for 2017.

New academies that opened in the 2015 to 2016 academic year can view their 2016 to 2017 question level analysis data by using their old URN/LAESTAB numbers.

More than 32,000 users are already using ASP. Guidance about logging in is available on YouTube.
