Action: deadline for submission of 2018 LA moderation plans extended

As <u>communicated</u> on Tuesday 26 September, all local authority moderation managers for early years foundation stage (EYFS), key stage 1 (KS1) and key stage 2 (KS2) are required to update their contact details and confirm moderation plans for the 2017 to 2018 test cycle.

The deadline for providing this information has been extended to Friday 15 December.

Publication: 2018 assessment and reporting arrangements (ARA)
