Information: changes to key stage 2 marking reviews for 2018

We have reviewed the criteria for a successful review of marking for the key stage 2 (KS2) national curriculum tests. Responding to feedback from schools and teaching unions, reviews will be classified as successful, and schools will not be charged, if there is a change to whether the pupil met the expected standard or not or if there is a change of 2 or more marks to the raw score, not 3 marks as in previous years.
