

Publication: moderator slides and materials available on NCA tools

Following the recent national training events for local authority (LA) moderation managers and lead moderators for key stage 1 (KS1) and key stage 2 (KS2) English writing, the <u>KS1</u> and <u>KS2</u> presentation slides and accompanying materials are now available for all schools and LAs on NCA tools.
