Stakeholder update

Action: respond to our survey on key stage 2 teacher assessment submission arrangements by 4 May

As in previous years, schools can choose to submit their key stage 2 (KS2) teacher assessment (TA) data, including P scales, to STA:

- using the NCA tools website
- via their local authority (LA)

If you collect and submit KS2 TA data on behalf of schools in your LA, you will have early sight of that data. You can use this to build comparative information and to inform provision for schools in the new academic year.

Please complete this <u>short survey</u> by Friday 4 May to inform us how KS2 teacher assessment data, including P scales, will be submitted within your LA. We will use the information to help us focus our communications and ensure data is collected quickly and efficiently from all LAs and schools.

Please remember that schools' <u>KS2 TA data</u>, including P scales, must be uploaded to <u>NCA tools</u> by Thursday 28 June.
