Action

Update 398 set out the requirement for all providers of adult education and training services to declare to us the actual level of funding paid and retained for each of their subcontractors in the academic year 2016 to 2017.

All providers that 'provision subcontracted' last year have been contacted by email. If you have returned your template, thank you.

If you have not yet returned your template you need to submit it to the <u>ESFA fees and charges mailbox</u> by 5pm on Friday 27 April 2018.
