## 2. Reminder: reporting gender your pay

## gap figures

The statutory deadline for reporting your gender pay gap figures for the 2018 to 2019 reporting year was Saturday 30 March 2019.

For trusts with 250 or more employees, please register with the government's gender pay gap reporting service as soon as possible and upload your figures. Guidance on reporting your figures is available.

If you have previously registered to report but now do not think you are in scope of the regulations for this reporting year, please change your status on the reporting service by logging onto the <u>reporting service</u>.

Please do this as soon as possible to ensure government records are accurate and to avoid any potential enforcement action for non-compliance.
