

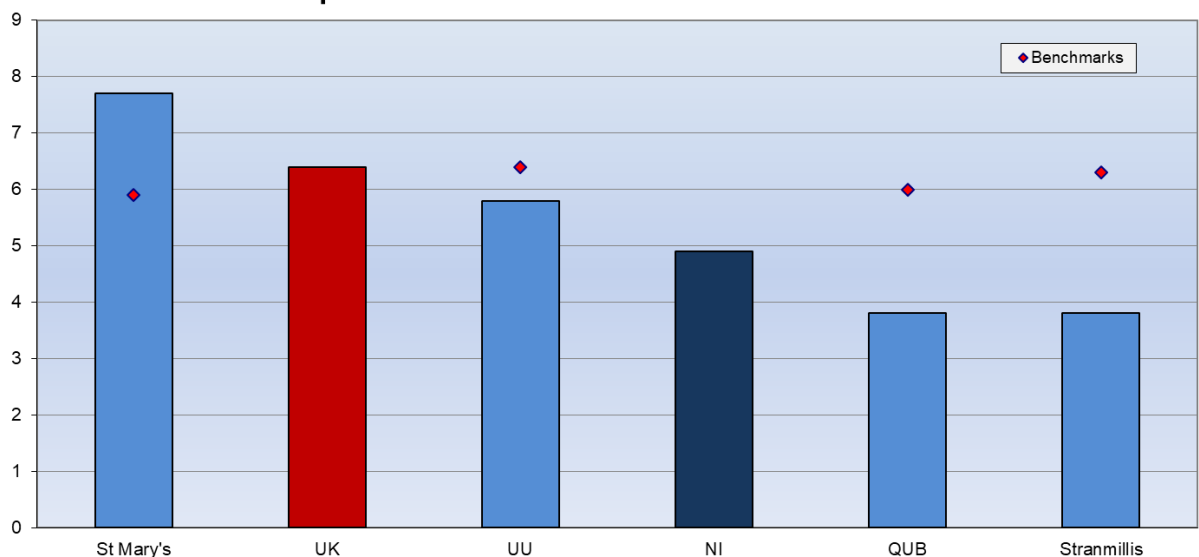
## Performance Indicators in Higher Education - 2018/19

### Widening Participation Fact Sheet

#### Participation of students who were in receipt of Disabled Students' Allowance (DSA): All undergraduate students - 2018/19

This indicator is designed to provide information about the percentage of students in receipt of Disabled Students' Allowance. For this indicator, a value higher than the benchmark<sup>1</sup> indicates that an institution was performing better than the sector average.

**Figure 1 : Percentage of full-time undergraduate students who were in receipt of Disabled Students' Allowance - 2018/19**



On average, NI Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) were performing below the UK average of 6.4%, with 4.9% of all full-time undergraduates in receipt of DSA in 2018/19.

St Mary's University College was performing above its benchmark, with 7.7% (benchmark 5.9%) of full-time undergraduates in receipt of DSA in 2018/19.

The proportions of full-time undergraduates in receipt of DSA in 2018/19 in Queen's University Belfast (QUB), Ulster University (UU) and Stranmillis University College were 3.8%, 5.8% and 3.8% respectively. However, all three institutions were performing below their benchmarks of 6.0%, 6.4% and 6.3% respectively. The Open University (OU) NI did not have a percentage for this Performance Indicator as all entrants for 2018/19 were part-time.

For part-time undergraduates, NI HEIs were performing above the UK average of 3.1%, with 4.2% in receipt of DSA.

**Participation of under-represented groups in Higher Education – mature and part-time entrants - 2018/19**
