As in previous years there are a number of amendments to the form, mainly to

cover any new reporting requirements and also to improve the user experience.

In summary, the main changes to this year's AR accounts return are:

 to introduce statement of financial activities (SoFA) and benchmarking fields to report COVID-19 (coronavirus) grant income

to limit counterparty reporting to transactions with the academy sector

- to updated SoFA and benchmarking fields to reflect new requirements to report rental and lettings income separately from 'Income from facilities and
- to introduce a new SoFA expenditure field so revenue and capital expenditure can be reported separately
