This update is to clarify what this means for the way school and college accountability will operate for 2019 to 2020.

We will not be publishing school, college or multi-academy trust (MAT) level performance data based on summer 2020 tests, assessments and exams at

any phase. We will not be publishing, or sharing, school, college or MAT level accountability measures, such as Progress 8 and level 3 value added, using the

The performance tables that were due to be released in October and December 2020, and in January and March 2021, will not go ahead.

We will also not publish any institution-level qualification achievement rates in

the national achievement rate tables for the 2019 to 2020 academic year.

Schools and colleges will receive details of grades awarded directly from awarding organisations. We will not run the primary, secondary or 16 to 18 school and college

We will not share the educational performance data from 2020 exams and

assessments with schools via Analyse School Performance, or through the ASP

institution level data on the 2020 grades to schools and colleges. We will not use the 2020 exams data when setting criteria in other areas, such

as teaching schools, English and maths hubs and free school applications.

Schools and colleges should not use the 2020 exams data as part of their

performance data checking exercises and will not return any pupil level or

All those working with schools and colleges, such as Ofsted, Department for

Education regional teams and local authorities, should use data from previous

years when assessing school and college performance, and not the 2020 data.
