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

1. Support eligibility

You can apply for support free of charge if you:

- have educational (or safeguarding) issues that have either been caused or exacerbated by coronavirus (COVID-19)
- are facing operational challenges because of coronavirus (COVID-19) and would benefit from additional leadership capacity including help with your remote learning offer

2. Support availability

Regional DfE teams administer the support offer, and will work with local authorities, dioceses, the Teaching Schools Council and local multi-academy trusts (MATs) to identify schools and trusts, which may benefit from support, and match them with an experienced school or trust leader.

Once we have identified a suitable leader to provide support, they will contact the school.

3. Support offered

Support will be in the form of dedicated time made available to the school and, where appropriate, its MAT, for up to 5 days. We may provide additional support to schools with particularly challenging needs.

System leaders will tailor the support to the individual needs of the school or trust, but it could include, for example, a focus on:

• how to use catch-up funding to address gaps in knowledge

support or planning with <u>remote learning</u>

- lost leadership capacity due to coronavirus (COVID-19) circumstances
