Timeline for the approval of post-16 qualifications at level 2 for 2025

Information for awarding organisations

Purpose

This document is a detailed timeline for qualifications submitted in Cycle 1 of the level 2 and below qualifications approval process, to be read alongside the Guide to the post-16 landscape at level 3 and below for 2025 and beyond [Review of post-16 qualifications at level 3 and below in England - GOV.UK \(www.gov.uk\)](https://www.gov.uk/government/consultations/review-of-post-16-qualifications-at-level-3-and-below-in-england). It is aimed at awarding organisations.

Dates

Date: 20 April to 5 June 2023

Action: Awarding organisation registers intent to submit qualification(s)

If you are an awarding organisation considering submitting a level 2 qualification for funding approval, we ask that you register your intention to submit. You must also confirm the qualification(s) you intend to submit are within your Ofqual scope of recognition to be regulated. Date: 19 May to 30 June 2023

Action: Awarding organisation submits proposal for additional specialist technical qualification.

If you are an awarding organisation considering submitting a level 2 additional specialist technical qualification that is not on the Institute for Apprenticeships and Technical Education's (IfATE)'s predefined list, you will need to first submit a qualification proposal to IfATE. Date: 13 November to 24 November 2023

Action: Awarding organisation submits qualifications for approval.

The Single Access Point ([GOV.UK](https://www.gov.uk/government/consultations/review-of-post-16-qualifications-at-level-3-and-below-in-england)) contains links to the Department for Education's (DfE) 2025 to 2026 qualifications funding approval manual, IfATE's published process and criteria for approval of level 2 technical qualifications. It will also link to Ofqual's regulations covering technical qualifications at level 2 which will be published by June 2023.

Date: Winter 2023 to Spring 2024

Action: DfE, IfATE and Ofqual review qualifications.

Qualifications will be reviewed against the criteria in DfE's 2025 to 2026 qualifications

funding approval manual. As only technical qualifications at level 2 are included in cycle 1, they will also be reviewed against IfATE's criteria. Ofqual will provide feedback to DfE and IfATE.

Date: 27 May to 13 June 2024

Action: Window for awarding organisations to update Ofqual Register of Regulated Qualifications.

On 14 June 2024, prior to completing the funding approval review, DfE will take a download of the information held on Ofqual's Register of Regulated Qualifications. By that date the awarding organisation must make sure that it has completed all the necessary information on Ofqual's Register.

Date: Summer 2024

Action: IfATE confirms decisions on whether to approve as technical qualifications.

IfATE will decide whether the qualification is approved as a technical qualification under the powers set out in the Skills Act. Applicants will be issued an approval decision which determines the eligibility of their technical qualification to be considered for public funding. If a qualification is not approved in one of IfATE's technical qualification categories, and the awarding organisation disagrees with how the final decision was reached, in certain circumstances IfATE will review its decision-making process. This is known as procedural review. The awarding organisation may be able to seek procedural review and should consult the guidance available on IfATE's procedural review page.

Date: 31 July 2024

Action: DfE informs awarding organisation of funding approval decisions.

DfE will review qualifications against the funding approval criteria. The DfE funding approval decision is separate and independent from Ofqual's recognition of awarding organisations and regulation of qualifications and IfATE's decision to approve technical qualifications. If a level 2 technical qualification is not approved for funding for one or more qualification offers, the awarding organisation may be able to ask DfE to review the outcome on the basis that the funding approval criteria have not been applied correctly. Date: 30 September 2024

Action: DfE publishes final list of level 2 qualifications with funding approval.

Qualifications that are approved for funding for 2025/26 will be published on the [List of Qualifications approved for funding \(education.gov.uk\)](https://www.education.gov.uk/qualifications)

Date: 1 August 2025

Action: Funding approval commences. Funding approval removed from qualifications not approved.

Delivery commences for qualifications approved for funding through this process. Level 2 qualifications which are aligned to supporting progression to employment in the following Sector Subject Areas will have their funding approval removed unless they have been approved through this process or exempted from the process.

Sector Subject Areas this applies to:

- child development and well-being
- health and social care
- science
- medicine and dentistry
- nursing and subjects and vocations allied to medicine
- building and construction
- engineering

Qualifications exempted:

- GCSEs
- Functional Skills Qualifications (FSQs) in English and maths
- Higher Project Qualifications
- Performing Arts Graded Exams
